FY 2021-22 LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kings County Association of Government's (KCAG) Transportation Policy Committee will hold a public hearing via teleconference on Wednesday, April 28, 2021, at 4:30 p.m. pursuant to Public Utilities Code, Section 99238.5, for the purpose of soliciting comments on the unmet transit needs within Kings County that may exist and that might be reasonable to meet by establishing or contracting for new public transportation or specialized transportation services or by expanding existing services; and for comments concerning needs for bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

KCAG has received claims for the FY 2021-22 Local Transportation Fund from the County of Kings and the cities of Avenal, Corcoran, Hanford, and Lemoore to use part of the Fund to support public transit. Up to 2% of the Local Transportation Fund may be used for bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The remainder of the Fund will be claimed by the above agencies to partially fund the regional transportation planning activities and for construction and maintenance of local streets and roads. Copies of the claims and the adopted Kings County Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) are available for review and may be provided by KCAG office upon request.

Anyone interested in the FY 2021-22 Local Transportation Fund claims or in identifying unmet transportation needs which can reasonably be met, is invited to make statements, present evidence, or give their comments regarding the claims.

Members of the public who wish to participate in the meeting electronically can do so one of two ways: via telephone using the Call in Number 866-866-2244 and Participant Code 1747304#, noted on the meeting agenda; or by postal or electronic mail.

The public may submit written comments on any matter within the KCAG Commission's subject matter jurisdiction, regardless of whether it is on the agenda for KCAG Commission consideration or action, and those comments will be entered into the administrative record of the meeting. To submit written comments by U.S. Mail or email for inclusion in the meeting record, they must be received by the KCAG Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on the afternoon of the noticed meeting.
