New Business:

1. Welcome & introductions – the members and non- member introduced themselves. Mrs. Hines welcomed and thanked everyone for joining us.
2. CAASPP results –Mrs. Hines shared that we improved overall in both ELA and Math. We are on a road of continuous improvement. Specific areas in ELA reading is the struggle is in research and inquiry. In Math problem solving is the struggle.
3. LCAP Annual Update/ Title I Program Evaluation/ Single School District Plan(SSDP):
 - a. Review: Student Achievement (Title I Evaluation Resource)
 - b. Discussion: Student Achievement Areas of Growth
 - c. Discussion: Student Achievement Areas of Needing Improvement
 - d. Review of metrics and outcomesMrs. Hines shared the areas the students have improved in. She shared we had reclassified three English Learners this year. We had 20% reclassification last year, and this year 17%. We only have 14 EL students. The EL's have improved overall in their ELPAC scores improving in English proficiency. She shared they additional have improved specifically in writing, written form and oral language. She shared the chronic absenteeism went from 2.8% to 5.8%, an increase of 3%. Mrs. Hines shared this brings us to the color of orange on the dashboard with the socioeconomically disadvantaged group in red. Any groups that drop two levels or are in orange or red the district is required to take assertive action to improve. We have many systems in place to support students with attendance. Because we are charter it is also part of their charter contract. There was a group of students that were chronically absent last year within the socioeconomically disadvantaged group that were not re-invited this year. We reviewed each of the state required metrics.
4. Other – Mrs. Hines shared in the next meeting we will be reviewing the Student Wellness Policy and the required items that will be added. Additionally, we will review the School Safety Plan. Tuesday Mrs. Hines will be attending the Boosters' Club meeting asking for input on the LCAP. She will then bring the input charts to the next ELAC, SSC, and both certificated and classified staff member meetings. We will review the LCAP input from each of the stakeholder groups at the following meeting.
